BORICA's WooCommerce plugin

Manual for migration to v.2

What's new

The plugin could be configured with different virtual POS terminals in BGN and/or EUR currency according to business needs.

Supports processing of customer information as required by cards payments schemes. Detailed information for the card payment in the order details with button for refunding the transaction.

BORICA Payments v.1.x for WordPress/WooCommerce is no longer supported.

Transactions made through BORICA Payments v.1.x plugin could not be refunded with v.2.x. In case you need to reverse some operation, you may ask your Bank for assistance.

Save locally and securely the private keys and their passwords. You don't need to reissue the private key and get new certificate. Just save them and use them in the newest version.

Updating to v.2 and Activation

1. Sign in to your *WordPress* site as an administrator
2. From your *WordPress dashboard* go to *Plugins > Add New*
3. Search for *Payments by BORICA - BORICA's WooCommerce plugin*. **Version 2.x will be available in WordPress marketplace after 20.01.2025.**
4. Click on '*Install Now*' button to install BORICA's WooCommerce plugin
5. Confirm version change
5. Find BORICA Payments in the list of *Installed plugins* and Deactivate it. Then Activate it again. **This step is mandatory!**
6. Once the plugin is activated it is visible under menu *Installed Plugins*

Plugin Setup

You may set up your virtual POS terminals in BGN and/or EUR currency according to the contract with your bank.

Enable:	Yes enables BORICA Payments
Mode of operation:	Changes Test/Production mode of BORICA Payments
Debug mode:	Enables/Disables debug mode

Basic settings:

Return URL (BackRef):	URL for receiving the result of request to APGW. This URL has to be set up in BORICAs systems. If your terminals are up and running, you don't need to do anything with it.
Merchant name:	Your customers will see this in their statement to identify the payment.
Payment failure message:	You can change this message to what with the text you want your customers to see when a payment fails.
Message on successful payment:	You can change this message with the text you want your customers to see upon successful payment.
Merchant email:	E-mail address for notifications.
Text color:	Select the color of the payment method text in your themes' scheme

Terminals configuration:

Merchant Identifier (MID):	Your Merchant ID, provided by your bank/BORICA
Terminal Identifier (TID):	ID of the terminal, provided by your bank/BORICA
Private key:	Enter your private keys for respective terminal for test and production environments
Private key password:	Type the password for your private key
Consistency check:	(Optional) Upload corresponding certificate issued by BORICA to check consistency

Additional settings:

Direct payment:	Enables/Disables direct payment mode. If enabled, a confirmation checkout page is skipped.
Show payment response:	Choose to show payment response with or without payment details (the thank you page)

Save the configuration.

Make sure you have available payment method in *WooCommerce* -> *Settings*-> *Payments* tab
